



## *Transitioning to raw food*

Transitioning a dog from dry food to raw food can be relatively straightforward, but its essential to do it gradually, especially if your dog has only ever eaten dry food. Here are some simple instructions for a slow and safe transition using food from Canterbury Pet Food Co.





# Transition Plan

## Step One - Food Selection

Select the appropriate food for your dog based on their age, breed, and activity level. We can help you choose the best options.

## Step Two - Slow Transition

Start by feeding a small portion of raw food in a separate meal from their dry food. It's best not to mix them in the same meal as it can make digestion more challenging for your dog.

Begin with a ratio of about 25% raw food and 75% dry food for the first few days. This gradual introduction helps your dog's system adjust to the new diet.

## Step Three - Gradual Increase

Over the next week or two, gradually increase the ratio of raw food while decreasing the amount of dry food until they are completely raw fed.

## Step Four - Monitor your dogs health

Pay attention to your dog's stool, energy level and overall health during this transition phase. It's not uncommon for dogs to experience slightly looser stools when transitioning to raw food. Their stools will likely become smaller on a raw diet, as they're utilizing more of the food.

## General Tips

**Introduce Variety:** Canterbury Pet Food Co offers a variety of protein options. Include different protein sources in your dog's raw diet to ensure they receive balanced nutrition.

**Maintain Hygiene:** Keep your dog's food and feeding area clean to minimise the risk of contamination. Discard any uneaten food and clean their bowl after each feeding.
